- SMART Sync 2011 software introduces Class List integration with SMART Response™ assessment software. When you add or remove a student in SMART Sync 2011, the same change appears in SMART Response software, if your SMART software products are administered through the SMART Sync school file.
- SMART Sync 2011 software introduces multiple operating system classrooms support. You can connect Windows teachers to Mac students and Mac teachers to Windows students.
- SMART Sync 2011 software supports Windows MultiPoint Server which enables multiple instances of SMART Sync Student software to run on the same computer.
- SMART Sync 2011 software features improved performance for viewing real-time screen captures of SMART Table™ interactive learning center activities in SMART Sync 2011.
- As an administrator, you can use the command line tool to import a Comma Separated Values (CSV) file containing school information from a third-party application to SMART Sync 2011 software.
- When you open SMART Sync Teacher software and there are no students connected to your class, a link appears in the Thumbnails view to the online Help for SMART Sync 2011 software.

Known issues

- If you upgrade from SMART Sync 2009 or 2010 software to SMART Sync 2011 software, you might experience issues with the software. Information will be available on the SMART support site (smarttech.com/support) to help you diagnose and troubleshoot these issues.
- When a teacher is observing a student's desktop and the student disconnects, Capture still appears to be enabled when it should be disabled.
